Arqiva SNGs transmit live surgery for the LINNC-ACINR (Live Interventional Neuroradiology and Neurosurgery Cases) Course

- **Arqiva's OU services broadcast live Neuroradiology and Neurosurgery cases to the medical community at the LINNC-ACINR Course in Turkey**

From 1-4 June Arqiva provided the Europa Organisation with satellite services to broadcast live Interventional Neuroradiology from hospitals in Ankara and Istanbul to the 2nd Joint Meeting of LINNC & ACINR in Istanbul.

Malcolm Campbell, Commercial Director at Arqiva Satellite & Media, said: "This is the fourth time we have provided satellite services for the LINNC Course and we are honoured to be entrusted with delivering broadcasts that really do help to save lives. We provided an SNG truck in Ankara and another in Istanbul, both providing dual uplink onto our W2A satellite space. The live transmissions were received by our deployed TVRO receive dish at the Istanbul convention centre. It's particularly gratifying to be involved in a broadcast that makes a real difference to people's lives and we look forward to continuing our work for the Europa Organisation and LINNC in the future."
